## CIRCULAR

It has been observed that though the cases relating to COVID-19 have been reduced in the NCT of Delhi, utmost precaution needs to be taken keeping in view the predicted third wave, limited availability of resources to fight against the pandemic and also the threat of Delta Plus, a variant of concern (VOC). Hence, we are required to strictly adhere to all due precautions in accordance with the advisories/guidelines issued by the Central/State Government(s), from time to time, so as to combat the pandemic effectively. It has, therefore, been decided that from 05.07.2021 to 23.07.2021 only fresh admission matters and matters involving extreme urgency shall be taken up through video conferencing and the cases already scheduled for listing during the said period shall be adjourned *en block* to subsequent dates to be notified in advance for information of all concerned.

However, on the request of the members of the Bar, the Competent Authority has been pleased to permit physical filing of cases at the Principal Bench from 01.07.2021 onwards.
