Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we find that no question of law much less any question of law of general public importance has been raised in this application filed under Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, seeking leave to appeal for impugning the order dated 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 passed by this Tribunal.

2. Seeking condonation of delay of 137 days in filing the application for leave to appeal, for which there is no satisfactory explanation, MA 1935/2023 has also been filed.

3. In view of the above, MA 1934/2023 is dismissed both on the ground of delay and merits.
