## <u>ORDER</u>

(Order of the Tribunal made by Hon'ble Justice V. Periya Karuppiah, Member (Judicial)

- 1. Heard Mr. A.R.Magudavel, learned counsel for the applicants, Mr. T.S.Selvaraj, learned counsel for the respondents-1 & 2 and Mr.K.Sannjay, learned counsel appearing for respondent-3 as well as Mr.K. Ramanamoorthy, learned CGSC representing Mr. V.Kadhirvelu, learned CGSC assisted by Major Suchithra Chellappan appearing for respondents-4 to 8.
- 2. During the course of advancing arguments, the learned counsel for the applicants and the learned counsel for the respondents-1 and 2 have sorted out the disputes between the applicants and respondents-1 and 2 and have reached a compromise. They have also submitted a Joint Memo extracting the compromise concluded between the applicants-1 and 2 on one part and respondents-1 and 2 on the other part. We have also perused the said Joint Memo which runs as follows:

## " JOINT MEMO FILED BY THE COUNSEL FOR APPLICANTS AND COUNSEL FOR RESPONDENTS-1 AND 2

It is submitted that on amicable solution arrived between the applicants and the respondents-1 and 2, the applicants

consented to receive 33% share of Army Group Insurance Fund deposited in Syndicate Bank, AGI Bhavan, New Delhi as per Cheque No.260442, dated 3.12.2010 along with accrued interest and on which willing to quit the other all claims, in favour of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondents."

- 3. The learned counsel for the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is also present and the compromise has been arrived at and recorded in his presence. The respondents-4 to 8 have also expressed no serious objection for the parties entering into a compromise. Therefore, there is no need for us to go into the merits of the case and the application is thus ordered in terms of the compromise. Accordingly, the applicant has consented to receive proceeds of 33% share of Army Group Insurance Fund deposited by 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in Syndicate Bank, AGI Bhavan, New Delhi through their cheque No.260442, dated 03.12.2010 with the accrued interest thereon and is willing to quit all their claims. The application is ordered accordingly.
- 4. The Joint Memo filed by both the counsel for the applicants and the respondents-1 and 2 shall form part of this order. No order as to costs.
