**NOTIFICATION**

It is hereby notified to the all concerned that for engagement of Legal Researcher (Purely on Temporary Basis) in Armed Forces Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, a written examination shall be conducted on *Saturday, 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2022* in the premises of **Armed Forces Tribunal, Principal Bench, West Block VIII, R. K. Puram Sector 1, New Delhi 110066** at **10:00 AM**.

**Guidelines/ Instructions For the Examination**

1. The question paper shall consist of 100 MCQs (Multiple Choice Questions) relating to (i) Criminal Law, (ii) Civil Law, (iii) Constitutional Law and (iv) General Aptitude (20 questions each) & Questions relating to (v) General knowledge and (vi) AFT Act, 2007 (10 questions each). Qualifying marks shall be 45%.
2. Candidates shall be shortlisted on the basis of merit list. Final selection shall be subject to verification of documents pertaining to education, date of birth, experience etc. If required, the Shortlisted Qualifying Candidates shall have to undergo an Interview/ Personality Test. The final decision in all respects shall vest with the **Hon'ble Chairperson, Armed Forces Tribunal**.
3. There shall be **negative marking** also. For every correct answer 1 Mark shall be awarded, and for every incorrect answer 0.25 Mark shall be deducted.
4. Candidates are required to report at the examination centre at least 45 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination (i.e. latest by 9:15 AM).
5. There shall be security frisking at the examination centre & candidates are not allowed to carry purses, wallets, mobile phones, watches or any other electronic device. Candidates are advised not to wear any jewellery at the time of examination. If any

candidate carries any such valuables to the examination centre and if the same are lost/ stolen, he/ she shall be personally liable for the same.

6. If any candidate is found indulging in any kind of unfair means practice, such case shall be immediately reported to concerned police station and to the Bar Council of India.
7. Candidates have to bring their ADHAAR CARD (in original) as Identity Proof, to the examination centre.
8. Candidates shall have to declare at the examination centre that they have not been tested Covid-19 positive in the last seven days.
9. All candidates shall follow appropriate Covid-19 protocols issued by Government of India & Government of NCT of Delhi.
10. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the website of AFT Delhi for updates, if any.
11. Admit cards can be downloaded from the official website of AFT five days prior to the date of examination.
12. Disputes, if any, shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi Courts.
13. No candidate shall be entitled for any TA/DA.
